




A 3rd of the way there!

Year #2 Has Begun! — Already !!

We are entering year #2 of the 3-year Forward To A Bright Future Capital Campaign for MVPC. With the very generous giving of our MVPC community, we have been able to accomplish our highest priority; to

bring our church "envelope" up to a safe, secure and welcoming place of worship. With our construction project, we have:



- Repaired and replaced composite roofing with new metal to match the Sanctuary & Good Shepherd Hall.
- Replaced siding with new metal and Hardie Plank material.
- Replaced windows, insulated and reglazed some others.
- Replaced the cross with a sturdy metal one (the original was in a state of disrepair).
- Cleaned and sealed exterior brick.
 - Painted the entire exterior of the building.
- Replaced several interior lights with new LED assemblies.
- Expanded our Guardian Security System throughout the church to meet Fire Code.

Many members contributed hours of volunteer work coordinating with Trico Companies LLC to complete and follow through on all the various areas needing upgrading.

As you peruse this newsletter, take note of what was made possible with faith, prayer and God's guidance in defining goals, uniting us in purpose, and again, your faithful financial generosity.

The construction loan of *\$600,000 was converted to a 15-year mortgage @ 4.25% effective 1/1/2021. We have made our first payment on the loan in the amount of \$ 4,513.67. Approximately ½ the payment goes to interest. One of our commitments to MVPC is to pay off the loan by the end of 2022. In order to do that, the Finance Committee plans to maintain an on-hand fund balance of at least 12 months of payments while we receive your contributions over the course of the year. We will make additional "principle" payments throughout the year to reduce the amount of interest we are paying. We will be tracking the monthly principle/interest/balance going forward, reporting back to you on a quarterly basis.

In addition to the loan, MVPC invested \$60,000 of our Operating Fund with Mission Development Certificates Northwest in the form of laddered CD's. This was a requirement for obtaining the loan and it provides us with investment income of approximately \$1,000+ per year at the same time.





You can see the FIRST Priority; that of "sealing the envelope", has been met!
